

Notes and Regulations for the Bancroft Art and Craft Guild Summer Show

- This is a juried show. All work on display and for sale must be original, quality work, hand made and created by the vendor. No commercial patterns or kits will be allowed. Only juried items will be allowed to be displayed and sold on the days of the show. Vendors will be asked to remove any items that are not within the juried medium, or within the above guidelines. While we recognize that creating various foodstuffs (i.e. candy, baked goods, jams, jellies, pickles) can be an art form, due to public health concerns, these are not allowed to be sold.
- 2) This is primarily an outdoor show. Vendors must supply their own canopies, tents, tables, chairs and backdrops as needed plus proper signage for your booth. There is limited indoor space at Club 580, which is adjacent to the park. Spaces will be assigned by the show committee. If you require indoor space, please indicate this on your application.
- 3) Set up time is Friday evening 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and Saturday morning 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. All vehicles must be clear of the show by 9:30 a.m. on both days. There will be security on Friday and Saturday evenings, but all merchandise should be removed.
- 4) The BACG and the AAC are not responsible for any loss or damage to property or personal injury.
- 5) All booths must remain open until the closing of the show (6:00 p.m. on Saturday and 4 p.m. on Sunday)
- 6) Cancellations up to 4 weeks before the show are eligible for a 50% refund; after that date, no refund will be issued.
- 7) Only one artist/vendor (and helpers) per booth is preferred. Any exceptions will be made on an individual basis.

All participants are asked to help with distribution of flyers and rack cards in their area. A digital poster will be emailed to you, please print and distribute in your area. Please contact us if you or a friend would like to volunteer to make this show a success. We need help with pre-show set up, during the show and clean up after the show.
